RING 1 IN – HAND CLASSES Starting at 9.30 am

- Class 1 YEARLING – Colt, Filly or Gelding born 2020.
- Class 2 YOUNGSTOCK – 2yr old - Colt, Filly or Gelding.
- Class 3 YOUNGSTOCK – 3yr old Colt, Filly or Gelding.
- Class 4 BEST CONDITIONED – Youngstock
- Class 5 PART BRED (any breed)
- Class 6 OPEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND (Excluding Welsh)
any height or age, plaited or unplaited.
- Class 7 SHETLAND AND MINITURE HORSE
- Class 8 PURE BRED WELSH Sections A & B Any age.
- Class 9 PURE BRED WELSH Sections C & D Any age.
- Class 10 COB TYPE – excluding Welsh
- Class 11 SHOW HUNTER – Any age
- Class 12 BEST CONDITIONED - 4 years and over - 13.2hh and under.
- Class 13 BEST CONDITIONED - 4 years and over - over 13.2 hh.
- Class 14 COLOURED/SPOTTED Any age (Excluding Palomino).
- Class 15 OPEN SHOWING - Any age, any height.
- Class 16 VETERANS Age 15 years and over.

RING 2 WORKING HUNTER CLASSES Starting on completion of Equitation Classes (Class 28) or not before 12.30pm

CLEAR ROUND (One Round Clear round rosette. (Pay at ringside). £2.00 per round). – **Open 11.00am – 12.30pm**

- Class 18 LEAD REIN/FIRST RIDDEN – 12.2hh and under (Rider 11 years and under). Snaffle Bridle only.
- Class 19 NOVICE PONY height 15hh and under - not to have won 1st Rosette in any working hunter class by the 01/01/21 (Snaffle Bridles only).
- Class 20 NOVICE HORSE height over 15 hh - not to have won 1st Rosette in any working hunter class by the 01/01/21 (Snaffle Bridles only).
- Class 21 OPEN PONY height 15hh and under
- Class 22 OPEN HORSE height over 15 hh
- Class 23 RIDING CLUB HORSE / PONY (Snaffle bridles only). To jump 1 small Jump

RING 3 EQUITATION/HANDLER/NOVELTES Starting at 9.45am

SNaffle BRIDLES / NO SPURS IN ALL EQUITATION CLASSES

- Class 24 17 years and over.
- Class 25 16 years and under
- Class 26 NOVICE (Rider not to have won 1st Rosette by 01/01/21).
- Class 27 12 years and under. (canter not compulsory).
- Class 28 LEAD REIN - Rider age 9 years or under (rider not to enter class 27).

Not before 12.15pm

- Class 29 TINY TOTS HANDLERS - handlers 7 years and under. (Parent/adult helper allowed in class)
- Class 30 YOUNG HANDLERS - handlers 8 - 12 years. (Colts and Stallions not allowed in this class).
- Class 31 JUNIOR HANDLERS - handlers 13 – 16 years. (Colts and Stallions not allowed in this class).

Followed by NOVELTY CLASSES - £2.50 each/ £ 8.00 for all 4

- Class 201,202,203, 204 To be decided on the day.
Members points for all four classes go towards Championship Trophy. Pony / Horse must be lead not ridden.

RING 4 **RIDDEN SHOWING** Starting at 9.30 am

- Class 32 BEST TURNED OUT - Horse/Pony & Rider.
- Class 33 COMBINED LEAD REIN 12.2hh and under. (Rider 9 years and under). Snaffle bridle only. (First place given to highest placed show pony/SHP **and** mountain & moorland exhibit)
- Class 34 FIRST YEAR FIRST RIDDEN Pony 12.2 and under (Rider 10 years and under), Snaffle bridle only. Walk and Trot ONLY. To only enter this class for one season.
- Class 35 FIRST RIDDEN PONY 12.2hh and under. (Rider 11 years and under). Snaffle bridle only.
- Class 36 RIDDEN COB (exc Welsh). Must be hogged and trimmed
- Class 37 TRADITIONAL COB (to be shown in natural state)
- Class 38 COLOURED / SPOTTED (excluding Palomino)
- Class 39 NOVICE SHOWING -14.2hh and under. Pony not to have won 1st rosette in any ridden showing by 1/1/21 Snaffle bridle only.
- Class 40 NOVICE SHOWING -over 14.2hh Horse / Pony not to have won 1st rosette in any ridden showing by 1/1/21 Snaffle bridle only.
- Class 41 OPEN SHOWING -14.2hh and under.
- Class 42 SHOW HUNTER PONY/HUNTER. First place given to highest placed show hunter pony **and** Hunter.
- Class 43 OPEN SHOWING -over 14.2hh.
- Class 44 VETERAN - Horse / Pony age 15 years and over.
- Class 45 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B. (To be shown in natural state) Rider any age. No spurs.
- Class 46 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BEEDS. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D (To be shown in natural state) Rider any age. No spurs.
